### **Overview**

For the last decade, St. Georges has had an active Sunday school program and a junior youth group for ages 8 through grade 8 that has provided opportunities for friendship, fun, and a place of belonging. Junior youth group events take place once every 1-2 months and have a variety of types of events at the church or elsewhere. The number of youth attending ranges between 8 and 20. In recent years, St. Georges also has a senior youth group aimed at high school age youth. The senior youth group has continued to meet via Zoom during the COVID-19 pandemic. In the past most of these ministries have been run entirely by volunteers, with the exception of the past two years where we have had a paid youth coordinator. In support of youth ministry at St. Georges, a part-time youth minister/pastor is sought to lead and organize the children/youth ministry team and provide an overall vision of the children and youth ministry at the church. Coming out of the pandemic we are looking to strengthen our children and youth ministry with the help of a child and youth minister/pastor.
