



St George's Anglican Church, Wharncliffe Rd N, London Auditions for Baritone and Alto Choral Scholar

The choir of St George's has an opportunity for a **baritone** (immediately) and an **alto** (from mid-October) **choral scholar**. The choral scholars provide a lead for their sections of the choir at the principal Sunday morning liturgy at 10:30 a.m.

Duties are one Thursday night rehearsal (7:00-8:30 p.m.), and Sunday morning Holy Eucharist (10:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.), for a total regular weekly commitment of four hours per week, September to June.

There are monthly services of Choral Evensong (currently the fourth Sunday of every month at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoon, with a 2:30 p.m. rehearsal)

The choir also sings extra services at Christmas and during Holy Week, and availability for attendance at the Nine Lessons & Carols service (the Sunday before Christmas), and the extra services in Holy Week and Easter, is an advantage.

Strong sight-reading and ensemble singing experience are helpful skills for the choral scholars to possess.

Auditions will be conducted by individual arrangement.

Pay is approximately \$4,100/annum, including additional fees for extra rehearsals and services.
